Abstract. A world catalogue of the family Jacobsoniidae (Coleoptera) is presented. It contains all taxa described to December 31, 2004.

INTRODUCTION

The family Jacobsoniidae is of uncertain relationships, provisionally placed within the series Bostrichiformia. The classification of the family follows Löbl & Burckhardt (1988), Lawrence & Newton (1995) and Lawrence et al. (1999). It includes 3 genera: *Sarothrias* Grouvelle, 1918, *Saphophagus* Sharp, 1886 and *Derolathrus* Sharp in Sharp & Scott, 1908 with 21 known species worldwide. All species are poorly represented in collections and little is known about their biology.

In addition to the taxonomic literature, the bibliography also includes papers dealing with biology, distribution, larvae and laboratory studies, and other theoretical and applied aspects.

The catalogue presents all known extant species and their distribution, described to December 2004, fossil species are not listed.




Fig. 1: *Sarothrias lawrencei* Löbl & Burckhardt, 1988:
