### New faunistics records of Mycetophagidae (Coleoptera: Tenebrionoidea)

Šíma lgt. et det., (ASPC); Indonesia, Java, Jakarta, yards of Sheraton hotel, 23.iv.2015, mostly at light, Shaverdo leg., 2 spec., J. Háva det. (HNMW, JHAC); Indonesia, Java, Jakarta, 28.2.1989, Jäch lgt., 1 spec., J. Háva det., (NHMW). Species known from Europe, Algeria, Egypt, Madeira Is., Morocco, Tunisia, Nigeria, Israel (Háva 2022), new to Albania and Indonesia: Java Is.

***Litargus (Alitargus) laosensis* Háva, 2021.** N Laos, Prov. Lg. Nam Tha, ca 10 km E Lg. Nam Tha, 600 m, 19.6.1996, leg. Schillhammer, 9 spec., (7 NHMW, 2 JHAC). Species known from Laos.

***Litargus (Litargosomus) exiguum* Olliff, 1883.** Indonesia, Bali Is., Bedugual reg., 1100-1300 m, Tamblingan Lakes N.P., 15-31.1.2019, local collector leg., 3 spec., J. Háva det., (JHAC). Species known from Indonesia: Borneo Is. (Háva 2022), new to Bali I.

***Litargus (Litargosomus) latus* Grouvelle, 1900.** Thailand, Tham Than Loi NP, 27.11.1990, Forster lgt., 7 spec., J. Háva det., (5 NHMW, 2 JHAC). Species known from Indonesia: Borneo Is. (Háva 2022), new to Thailand.

***Litargus (Litargus) connexus* (Geoffroy, 1785).** Taiwan, Tao-Yuan Hsien, Pa Lin, 1000 m, 22.4.1993, Lo lgt., 1 spec., J. Háva det., (JHAC). Species known from Europe, Canary Is., Egypt, Morocco, Sudan, Tunisia, China, Cyprus, Iran, Israel, Japan, Jordan, Kazakhstan, Kyrgyzstan, Mongolia, North Korea, Oman, Syria, Turkey, Uzbekistan (Háva 2022), new to Taiwan.

***Litargus (Litargus) gigas* Grouvelle, 1914.** Gabon, Ogooué Ivindo, P.N., Ivindo Station de Recherche d'Ipassa, 450 m, 0°30'43''N, 12°48'12''E, 14-26.vi.2016, Ruzzier E., Tasane T. leg., Trip Ref: GA-001 (ANHRT-19) / BMNH(E) 2016-152 / 1 spec., *Litargus gigas* E. Ruzzier det., J. Háva revid., (BMNH). Species is described from „German west Africa [= Cameroon]“ (Háva 2022), new to Gabon.

***Mycetophagus (Ilendus) yunnanus* Háva, 2019.** China, Yunnan, Heishui, 35 km N of Lijiang, 27°13'N 100°19'E, 1-19.vii.1992, E. Jendek lgt., 1 spec., J. Háva det., (NHMW). Species known from China: Yunnan prov., new locality data from Yunnan.

***Mycetophagus (Mycetophagooides) alni* Champion, 1917.** India, West Bengal, Kalimpong, 27°06'N 88°43'E, 625 m, 1-11.xii.2013, Tomkovich K. lgt., J. Háva det., (JHAC). Species known from Nepal, India: Uttar Pradesh, Uttarakhand (Háva 2022), new to India: West Bengal.

***Mycetophagus (Mycetophagus) weigeli* Háva, 2020.** CH: Yunnan/Xishuangbanna, 37 km NW Jinghong, vic. Guo Men-Shan (NNNR), 1100 m, 22°14.43N 100°36.12E, 18.vi.2019, leg. A. Weigel, KL, 13 spec., (9 NMED, 4 JHAC). Species is described from Yunnan prov.

***Mycetophagus (Ulolendus) antennatus* (Reitter, 1879).** „Tenasserim, M. Mooleyit, 1000-1900 m, Fea, Apr. 1887“, 1 spec., J. Háva det., (MCSN); N Thailand, DoiInthanon, 1200 m, Bang Khun Klang, 19-26.6.1989, Malicky leg., 1 spec., J. Háva det., (JHAC). Species known from China: Inner Mongolia, Guangxi, Japan, Mongolia, Russia, Taiwan and Vietnam (Háva 2022), new to Myanmar and Thailand.

***Mycetophagus (Ulolendus) fraternus* Grouvelle, 1911.** Nepal W, Karnali prov., Humla Distr., between Simikot, 29°57'3.01''N 81°50'32.90''E, 16.vi.2022, 2200 m, creek valley, tree fungi, D. Telnov leg., 1 ♀, J. Háva det., (JHAC). Species known from India: Sikkim and Darjeeling (Háva 2022), new to Nepal.

***Mycetophagus (Ulolendus) hyrcanicus* Nikitsky, 1989.** Iran, Golestan prov., Gorgan distr., near Ziarat vill., 27.v.2016, D. Kasatkin lgt., 1 ♂, A. Azarov det., J. Háva revid., (JHAC). Species known from Azerbaijan, new to Iran.

***Typhaeola aethiopica* (Grouvelle, 1908).** Tanzania, Arusha, Mt. Meru, 1800-2000 m, 6-7.4.1997, Pavel Senft lgt., 1 ♀, J. Háva det., (JHAC); Kenya, Thika (9), 7.xii.1989, M. Jäch leg., 2 spec., J. Háva det., (NHMW). Species known from Ethiopia (Háva 2022), new to Kenya and Tanzania.

***Typhaea stercorea* (Linnaeus, 1758).** Saudi Arabia, distr. Faifa', 10 km W of Faifa', 17°15'37''N 43°04'n07'E, 660 m, 21-23.iii.2022, P. Kabátek lgt., Typhaea sp. T. Růžička det., 1 ♂, J. Háva det., (TRPC); S-Iran, 16 km E Bandar-Abbas, lichtfang (14), 264.1974, Exped. Mus. Vindob., leg. Pretzmann, 3 spec., J. Háva det., (2 NHMW, 1 JHAC); Iran, Manujan, 110 km E Bandarabbas, 2.5.1974, leg. Pretzmann, 1 spec., J. Háva det., (NHMW); Thailand, 240 km nr. Bangkok, 110 m, 25 km nw. Lan Sak, lichtfang, Jan.1989, leg. Thielen, 4 spec., J. Háva det., (3 NHMW, 1 JHAC); NW Thailand, Chom Ihong, 24-27.4.1991, Dembický lgt., 1 spec., J. ## **Corrections:**

Háva (2022) erroneously mentioned the genus *Pseudesarcus* Champion, 1913 with type species *Pseudesarcus villosus* Champion, 1913 (Panama) in family Mycetophagidae. Bousquet et al. (2018) mentioned the genus and species in family Tenebrionidae, subfamily Lagriinae as incertae sedis, from family Mycetophagidae transferred the genus by Lawrence & Newton (1995). Other corrections in the genera *Litargus* Erichson, 1846 and *Mycetophagus* Fabricius, 1792 published by Háva (2023).
